



The event will take place at the University of Warsaw, one of the oldest university in Poland, founded on November 19, 1816. Interestingly, it was created by merging previously existing schools, including School of Law and Administrative Sciences, founded in 1808 and whose tradition is followed by the Faculty of Law and Administration at the University of Warsaw. UW is currently the largest university in Poland.



## The Columned Hall (20th of April, 17:00)

The Columned Hall (Sala Kolumnowa) is one of the most beautiful, classical interiors in Warsaw. The Hall is located at the Faculty of History. The total area is 375 m2 with max. 150 seats. and the dinner will be served in the back of the Hall.

## Main Hall at the former Library Building (21st of April, 8:45-17:30, 22nd of April, 9:30-14:00)

The Hall is one of the most modern conference spaces at the University of Warsaw. With 362 m2 and 376 seats, it's often used for conferences, panel sessions and special events. Lunch will be served in the corridors right next to the Hall.

## Seminar Hall at the Faculty of Law and Administration
