### ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ISSUES – YESTERDAY, TODAY, TOMORROW?

#### **Course description:**

Participants will acquire knowledge of theoretical and practical issues of environmental protection from the historical beginnings of the basic principles of environmental protection, specific aspects of achieving adequate legal protection of the environment within various branches of law (commercial, maritime, insurance, civil, criminal, criminal procedure, family, international private), but also a sociological approach to the topic of environmental protection. The ultimate goal is to explore the advantages and disadvantages of existing solutions at the international and European level (in theory and practice) and to point out the necessity of an interdisciplinary, global approach to environmental protection.

The course consists of lectures, seminars and workshops and exercises.
