- **ORGANIZOVANA KONFERENCIJA – „Rodna načela u visokom obrazovanju: dobre međunarodne prakse i lokalni kontekst“, 20. oktobar 2017.**

Konferenciju je organizovao Centar za ljudska prava uz podršku Misije OEBS-a u Srbiji, za učesnike iz Nemačke, Švedske, Finske, Holandije, Češke i Srbije. U okviru konferencije održan je i okrugli sto na temu „Put ka sveobuhvatnim rešenjima za uvođenje rodne perspektive u politike visokog obrazovanja“, na kojoj su prisustvovali najviši predstavnici obrazovnih institucija, državnih organa, nezavisnih nadzornih institucija u Srbiji, kao i predstavnici domaćih i stranih institucija uključenih u proces pridruživanja Srbije Evropskoj uniji. Oni su ukazali na praktična dostignuća i vizije u vezi sa politikama rodne ravnopravnosti u okviru svojih nadležnosti.

- **IZRADA RODNOG AKCIONOG PLANA (GAP) PRAVNOG FAKULTETA 2018.**

Nastavljena je saradnja Pravnog fakulteta i Misije OEBS-a u Srbiji iz oblasti rodne ravnopravnosti u cilju izrade prvog rodnog akcionog plana (GAP) za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti u visokom obrazovanju u Srbiji, koji će biti kreiran za Pravni fakultet. Rad na Nacrtu akcionog plana za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti započet je 2018. godine, kada je zadatak izrade ovog dokumenta delegiran istraživačkom timu Centra za ljudska prava, koji su činili profesori prava: prof. dr Dragica Vujadinović, prof. dr Ljubinka Kovačević, prof. dr Tanasije Marinković i prof. dr Ivana Krstić.

- **OKRUGLI STO ZA DISKUSIJU O NACRTU AKCIONOG PLANA, 17.12.2018.**

Pozdravne reči održali su prof. dr Zoran Mirković, dekan Pravnog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu, prof. dr Ivanka Popović, rektorka Univerziteta u Beogradu, Džon Klejton, šef Odeljenja za demokratizaciju Misije OEBS-a u Srbiji, prof. dr Ivana Krstić, upravnik Instituta za pravne i društvene nauke i Centra za ljudska prava Pravnog fakulteta, kao i prof. dr Zorana Mihajlović, potpredsednica Vlade Srbije i predsednica Koordinacionog tela za rodnu ravnopravnost. Tokom diskusije, različiti učesnici su izneli važne komentare o Nacrtu akcionog plana za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu. Moderatorica okruglog stola bila je prof. dr Dragica Vujadinović.

- **STUDIJSKA POSETA HUMBOLT UNIVERZITETU I SLOBODNOM UNIVERZITETU U BERLINU, 2019.**

Pored sugestija i predloga iznetih na ovom okruglom stolu, doprinos daljem unapređenju Nacrta akcionog plana za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu bila je i studijska poseta prof. dr Dragice Vujadinović, prof. dr Ivane Krstić i prof. dr Ljubinke Kovačević univerzitetima u Berlinu, čiji je cilj bio razmena iskustava vezanih za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti u pravnom obrazovanju. Poseta je organizovana uz podršku Misije OEBS-a u Srbiji. Na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta Humbolt, delegaciju su ugostile prof. dr Susanne Baer, profesorka i sudija Saveznog ustavnog suda Nemačke, i prof. dr Ulrike Lembke. Tema razgovora bili su glavni izazovi i ključni problemi koji se javljaju prilikom uvođenja rodno osetljivih sadržaja u pravno obrazovanje, kao i metode podučavanja učenika o rodnoj ravnopravnosti. U nastavku studijske posete organizovan je sastanak sa predstavnicima Centra za rodne studije Margherita von Brentano na Slobodnom Univerzitetu u Berlinu prof. dr Martin Lücke, šefom Centra i dr Heike Pantelmann, predstavnicom Slobodnog Univerziteta u Berlinu u okviru radne grupe centara za ženske i rodne studije na visokoškolskim ustanovama u Berlinu. Razgovor je bio posvećen pravnim i vanpravnim merama od značaja za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti i prevenciju seksualnog uznemiravanja na visokoškolskim ustanovama. Studijsko putovanje je završeno sastankom u Rektoratu Slobodnog univerziteta u Berlinu, sa prof. dr Herbert Grieshop, direktorom Kancelarije za međunarodne poslove Slobodnog univerziteta u Berlinu, prof. dr Mechthild Koreuber, Glavnom službenicom za rodnu ravnopravnost na Slobodnom univerzitetu u Berlinu, njenom zamenicom Wendy Stollberg i profesorkom krivičnog prava i kriminologije dr Kirstin Drenkhahn. U razgovoru je bilo reči o efikasnosti mera za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti među zaposlenima na univerzitetima, kao i o merama prevencije i zaštite od diskriminacije po osnovu pola/roda i seksualnog uznemiravanja u visokom obrazovanju.

- **OBJAVA RODNOG AKCIONOG PLANA - Postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu: Studija istraživanja i politike, plus: ANEKS I – UREDBA O PREVENCIJI I ZAŠTITI OD SEKSUALNOG UZNEMIRENJA NA UNIVERZITETU U BEOGRADU, PRAVNI FAKULTET, 2021.**

Ove aktivnosti, kao i brojne diskusije sa kolegama u Srbiji, umnogome su doprinele daljem unapređenju Nacrta akcionog plana za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu, a konačan rezultat je bila dvojezična publikacija.

- **Novi kvalitet u obrazovanju za rodnu ravnopravnost - Projekat strateškog partnerstva za razvoj master studija PRAVO I ROD (LAWGEM), oktobar 2019. - decembar 2022.**

Pravni fakultet je dobio finansijska sredstva od Evropske komisije za realizaciju međunarodnog projekta za kreiranje Master studijskog programa Pravo i rod. Zbog veoma dobrih rezultata LAWGEM projekta, evaluatori Evropske komisije su ga ocenili sa 95 poena od mogućih 100 i najavili da ovaj projekat predstavlja dobar primer za sve ostale Erasmus projekte.

Koordinator projekta je bio Univerzitet u Beogradu, dok je glavna koordinatorka programa prof. dr Dragica Vujadinović. Ostali članovi Konzorcijuma bili su: Pravni fakultet Univerziteta LUMSA, Palermo, Italija; Fakultet prava, psihologije i socijalnog rada Univerziteta Orebro, Švedska; Europa-Institut na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Sarlandu, Nemačka; i

Univerzitet u Kadizu, Španija. U realizaciji ovog projekta učestvovalo je više od trideset profesora i asistenata sa Pravnog fakulteta, dok je ceo LAWGEM istraživački tim činilo više od devedeset istraživača sa pet univerziteta u pet zemalja. Ključni intelektualni rezultat projekta bilo je kreiranje studijskog programa Pravo i rod na master akademskim studijama, koji će biti posvećen postizanju rodno kompetentnih i rodno osetljivih znanja u najvažnijim pravnim i vanpravnim naučnim disciplinama. Planirano je da nastavni plan i program ovog master programa akredituju svi članovi Konzorcijuma. Pravni fakultet LUMSA Univerziteta je ovaj program već akreditovao i počeo sa izvođenjem 2022/23. godine, dok je Pravni fakultet Univerziteta u Beogradu u procesu akreditacije master programa.

Drugi ključni intelektualni rezultat je vezan za izdavanje udžbenika, sa poglavljima koja pokrivaju sve obavezne i izborne predmete ovog studijskog programa. Naziv udžbenika je Rodno kompetentno pravno obrazovanje (d. Vujadinović, M. Froehlich, Th. Giegerich eds.), Springer 2023. Knjiga je objavljena kao „*open access*“ knjiga, sadrži 18 poglavlja (plus Uvod) i pokriva sve relevantne oblasti pravnog obrazovanja preispitane iz perspektive rodne ravnopravnosti. U pisanju pomenutih 18 poglavlja učestvovalo je 66 autora, koji pripadaju svim univerzitetskim partnerima u konzorcijumu. Utoliko, ovaj udžbenik predstavlja pionirski doprinos u smislu sistemskog preispitivanja celokupnog pravnog znanja iz feminističke perspektive, ali i u smislu timskog rada.

Treći intelektualni rezultat bilo je osnivanje **Pravne klinike za rodnu ravnopravnost (GELC)**.

Četvrti intelektualni rezultat je kreirana „*Lifelong*“ **Platforma za učenje** za obrazovanje o rodnoj ravnopravnosti LLLP <http://lawgem.ius.bg.ac.rs>).

Poslednji, peti intelektualni rezultat je **Empirijski alat za istraživanje (EST)**, koji uključuje desk istraživanje i upitnik, koji pokrivaju različita pitanja u vezi sa institucionalnim, obrazovnim i kulturnim okvirima akademske zajednice, a predložen je da služi za ispitivanje stavova akademskog osoblja u vezi sa pitanjima rodne ravnopravnosti u slučaju svih članica Konzorcijuma, a potom i za uporednu analizu dobijenih rezultata.

Projekat LAWGEM je takođe proizveo brojne rezultate s dodatnom vrednosti, uključujući sedam objavljenih knjiga tokom 2021. i 2022. godine i jedan članak.

Dodatne aktivnosti:

- **POZIV ZA NAJBOLJI STUDENTSKI RAD, 2020**

Centar za ljudska prava raspisao je, u saradnji sa Misijom OEBS-a u Srbiji, a u skladu sa predloženim ciljevima i merama Nacrta akcionog plana za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu, konkurs za najbolji studentski rad, koji se dodeljuje u čast Marine Blagojević Hughson, na opštu temu „Uticaj pandemije COVID-19 na rodnu ravnopravnost“. Tema je odabrana imajući u vidu ideju da su pandemije izazvale različite posledice na muškarce i žene i da bi strateške mere trebalo da uzmu u obzir ovu činjenicu, sa ciljem ublažavanja i suzbijanja ovih nejednakosti. Shodno tome, studenti svih studijskih programa Pravnog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu su pozvani da napišu rad na ovu temu,

koji je značajno doprineo pravilnom i potpunom razumevanju rodne ravnopravnosti u oblasti prava, posebno u vreme vanrednog stanja.

- **UniSAFE PROJEKAT – Učešće Univerziteta u Beogradu u UniSAFE projektu, 2019-2022.**

UniSAFE je bio trogodišnji istraživački projekat finansiran od strane EU. Njegova poruka je bila da je vreme da se okonča seksualno uznemiravanje i rodno zasnovano nasilje u akademiji i istraživanjima. UniSAFE skraćenica znači – univerziteti sigurni od rodno zasnovanog nasilja. Cilj ovog projekta, u kome je Univerzitet u Beogradu bio spoljni partner, bio je da proizvede temeljno znanje o rodno zasnovanom nasilju i seksualnom uznemiravanju u istraživačkim organizacijama, i da ovo istraživanje prevede u operativne alate za visoko obrazovanje i istraživačke organizacije.

Tokom tri godine, istraživačke i terenske aktivnosti su vođene širom Evrope, ciljajući istraživače, zainteresovane strane i kreatore politika. Ideja projekta je da analizira mehanizme rodno zasnovanog nasilja – njegove društvene odrednice, prethodnike i posledice – na tri različita nivoa, koristeći holistički model istraživanja, bazirajući analizu na podacima prikupljenim anketom među 45 RPO (mikro nivo), o istraživanju organizacionih odgovora i infrastrukture na osnovu podataka prikupljenih detaljnim studijama slučaja, intervjuima i strateškom mapiranju istraživačkih organizacija u 15 država članica (mezo nivo), i o ispitivanju pravnih i političkih okvira kroz opsežno mapiranje od strane nacionalnih stručnjaka u 27 evropskih država i 3 pridružene države (makronivo).

Ovaj multidisciplinarni dizajn istraživanja pokušava da pruži opširno znanje o postojećim problemima rodno zasnovanog nasilja u akademskim krugovima i istraživanjima, da razgraniči trenutne i buduće prioritete i da kao rezultat ponudi operativni alat i preporuke za smanjenje rodno zasnovanog nasilja. u evropskom akademskom i istraživačkom prostoru.

- **PROLEĆNA ŠKOLA, 22. maj - 5. jun 2023, hibridni format**

U cilju pripreme akademskog osoblja za realizaciju ovog master programa, na Pravnom fakultetu održana je „Prolećna škola - Pravo i rod“ uz podršku Misije OEBS-a u Srbiji. Na prolećnoj školi učestvovalo je ukupno 69 kandidata, među kojima su učešće uzeli srpski (47) i međunarodni (22) studenti osnovnih i doktorskih studija. Učesnici su bili iz različitih zemalja, uključujući Albaniju, Belorusiju, Bosnu i Hercegovinu, Brazil, Kinu, Hrvatsku, Francusku, Nemačku, Indiju, Iran, Italiju, Crnu Goru, Rusiju, Srbiju i Vijetnam, pokazujući svoju posvećenost i intenzivnu uključenost tokom dvosedmične škole.

Svi polaznici su morali da završe četiri obavezna predmeta: Feminističke političke i pravne teorije, Pravo ljudskih prava sa rodnom perspektivom, Međunarodno i evropsko pravo i rodna ravnopravnost i Feminističke presude. Pored toga, bili su obavezni da pohađaju dva obavezna kursa zasnovana na veštinama: metodologiju i praktične veštine i Pravnu kliniku za rodnu ravnopravnost. Štaviše, svaki student je imao priliku da izabere pet fakultativnih kurseva iz grupe od ponuđenih jedanaest. Izborni predmeti su uključivali javno pravo i rodnu ravnopravnost, rodna pitanja u uporednoj pravnoj istoriji, rodnu ekonomiju, rodnu ravnopravnost i privredno pravo, rodno pravedno oporezivanje, rodno kompetentno kriminologiju, rodno kompetentno krivično pravo, rodno kompetentno porodično pravo, sociologiju prava i rodnu ravnopravnost, javne politike i rodna ravnopravnost i rodna

perspektiva u radnom pravu. Svaki kurs se sastojao od tri predavanja, uz kontinuirano podsticanje aktivnog učešća studenata i diskusija.

- **LAWGEM NASTAVAK PRIJAVA ZA MEĐUNARODNE PROJEKTE**

Univerzitet Orebro, Univerzitet LUMSA i Pravni fakultet Univerziteta u Beogradu dobili su u julu 2023. godine finansijska sredstva za *Erasmus Design Measures Program* (EMDM) pod nazivom PRAVO, ROD, UKRŠTENOST I RAZLIČITOST (LAWGID), koji će trajati 15 meseci, a koji ima za cilj pripremu prijavu za *Erasmus Mundus Joint Master* (EMJM) sa istim naslovom.

FACULTY OF LAW AND PROMOTION OF GENDER EQUALITY

The Faculty of Law academic staff has expressed a strong interest and devotion to developing gender-competent legal knowledge, preventing sexual harassment at the faculty, and overcoming gender biases and prejudices in the educational pedagogical approaches, and in lectures in different fields of legal education. The already conducted activities and numerous results will be listed and explained.

- **ORGANIZING THE CONFERENCE – „Gender Mainstreaming in Higher Education: International Good Practices and Local Contexts “, 20 October 2017**

The conference was organized by the Centre for Human Rights with the support of the OSCE Mission to Serbia for participants from Germany, Sweden, Finland, the Netherlands, Czechia, and Serbia. The conference also included a roundtable devoted to the topic ‘Towards all-encompassing solutions for introducing gender perspective into policies of higher education’, and the highest representatives of educational institutions, governmental bodies, independent control institutions in Serbia, as well as representatives of the domestic and foreign institutions involved in the process of Serbia’s accession to the European Union, pointed out the practical achievements and visions of gender equality policies in the scopes of their competences.

- **PUBLISHED BOOK - *Gender Equality in Higher Education: Concepts, Practices and Challenges*, 2019**

The presentations from the conference were later published in the book *Gender Equality in Higher Education: Concepts, Practices, and Challenges* (Dragica Vujadinović, Zorana Antonijević (eds.), Akademska knjiga, Novi Sad, 2019).

- **DRAFTING THE FACULTY OF LAW’S GENDER ACTION PLAN (GAP), 2018**

The cooperation between the Faculty of Law and the OSCE Mission to Serbia in the field of gender equality continued in the drafting of the first gender action plan (GAP) for achieving gender equality in higher education in Serbia, to be created for the Faculty of Law. Work on the Draft Action Plan for Achieving Gender Equality was initiated in 2018 when the task to create this document was delegated to the research team of the Centre for Human Rights, consisting of law professors: Prof. Dr. Dragica Vujadinović, Prof. Dr. Ljubinka Kovačević, Prof. Dr. Tanasije Marinković, and Prof. Dr. Ivana Krstić.

- **ROUND TABLE FOR DISCUSSING THE DRAFT ACTION PLAN, 17 December 2018**

The welcome speeches were held by Prof. Dr. Zoran Mirković, Dean of the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law, Prof. Dr. Ivanka Popović, Rector of the University of Belgrade, John Clayton, Chief of the OSCE Mission to Serbia Democratization Department, Prof. Dr. Ivana Krstić, Head of Institute for Legal and Social Sciences and the Centre for Human Rights at the Faculty of Law, and Prof. Dr. Zorana Mihajlović, Deputy Prime Minister of Serbia and the

Chair of the Coordination Body for Gender Equality. During the discussion, the fruitful comments about the Draft Action Plan for Achieving Gender Equality at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law were presented by different participants. The moderator of the roundtable was Prof. Dr. Dragica Vujadinović.

- THE STUDY VISIT TO HUMBOLDT UNIVERSITY AND FREIE UNIVERSITÄT IN BERLIN, 2019

In addition to the suggestions and proposals presented at this roundtable, a contributing factor to the further advancement of the Draft Action Plan for Achieving Gender Equality at the Faculty of Law was the study visit to universities in Berlin by Dr. Dragica Vujadinović, Dr. Ivana Krstić, and Dr. Ljubinka Kovačević, the aim of which was to exchange experiences related to achieving gender equality in legal education. The visit was organized with support from the OSCE Mission to Serbia. At the Humboldt University Faculty of Law, the delegation was hosted by Dr. Susanne Baer, professor and Justice of the Federal Constitutional Court of Germany, and professor Dr. Ulrike Lembke. The topic of the discussion was the main challenges and key problems that arise when introducing gender-sensitive content into legal education, as well as the methods of teaching gender equality to students. In the follow up to the study visit, the meeting was organized with the representatives of the Margherita von Brentano Centre for Gender Studies at Freie Universität Berlin Prof. Dr. Martin Lücke, the head of the Centre, and Dr. Heike Pantelmann, the representative of the Freie Universität Berlin in (Arbeitsgemeinschaft der Frauen– und Geschlechterforschungseinrichtungen Berliner Hochschulen), a working group of the centers for women’s and gender studies at higher education institutions in Berlin. The conversation was devoted to legal and non-legal measures of importance for achieving gender equality and for the prevention of sexual harassment at higher education institutions. The study trip was concluded with a meeting at the Rectorate of the Freie Universität Berlin, with Prof. Dr. Herbert Grieshop, director of the Office for International Affairs at the Freie Universität Berlin, Prof. Dr. Mechthild Koreuber, the Chief Gender Equality Officer at Freie Universität Berlin, her deputy Wendy Stollberg, and Professor of Criminal Law and Criminology Dr. Kirstin Drenkhahn. The discussion covered the efficiency of the measures for achieving gender equality among the employees of the universities, as well as the measures for prevention of and protection against discrimination based on sex/gender and sexual harassment in higher education.

- GENDER ACTION PLAN PUBLICATION - Achieving Gender Equality at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law: Research and Policy Study, plus: ANNEX I – REGULATION ON THE PREVENTION OF AND PROTECTION AGAINST SEXUAL HARASSMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF BELGRADE FACULTY OF LAW, 2021

These activities, as well as numerous discussions with colleagues in Serbia, contributed greatly to further improvements of the Draft Action Plan for Achieving Gender Equality at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law, and the final result was the bi-lingual publication.

- **New Quality in Education for Gender Equality - Strategic Partnership for the Development of Master`s Study Programme LAW AND GENDER (LAWGEM) project, October 2019 - December 2022**

Faculty of Law received a grant from the European Commission for implementing the international project for creating the Law and Gender Master study programme. Due to the very rich final outcomes of the LAWGEM project, the European Commission`s evaluators estimated it with 95 points from a possible 100 and announced this project to represent a good example for all other Erasmus projects.

The coordinator of the project was the University of Belgrade, and the head coordinator was Prof. Dr. Dragica Vujadinović. Other members of the consortium were: the LUMSA University Department of Law, Palermo, Italy; Örebro University School of Law, Psychology and Social Work, Sweden; Europa-Institut at the University of Saarland Faculty of Law, Germany; and the University of Cadiz, Spain. More than thirty professors and assistants from the Faculty of Law took part in the implementation of this project, while the whole LAWGEM research team consisted of more than ninety researchers from five universities in five countries. The crucial intellectual output of the project was the creation of the Law and Gender study programme of Master academic studies, which will be devoted to achieving gender-competent and gender-sensitive knowledge in the most important legal and non-legal scientific disciplines. The plan is for this master`s programme curriculum to be accredited by all Consortium members. The Faculty of Law at LUMSA University has already accredited this master`s programme and started to conduct it in 2022/23. Also, the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade has been in the process of the master`s accreditation.

Another crucial intellectual output is related to publishing the textbook, with chapters covering all mandatory and optional courses of this study programme. The title of the textbook is *Gender Competent Legal Education* (D. Vujadinovic, M. Froehlich, Th. Giegerich eds.), Springer 2023. The book is published as an open-access book, contains 18 chapters (plus an Introduction), and covers all relevant fields of legal education reconsidered from a gender equality perspective. 66 authors took part in writing the mentioned 18 chapters, and they belong to all the university`s consortium partners. Insofar, this textbook represents a pioneering contribution in terms of a systemic reconsidering of the whole legal knowledge from a feminist perspective and in terms of teamwork.

The third intellectual output was the established **Legal Clinic for Gender Equality (GELC)**.

The fourth intellectual output was the created **Lifelong Learning Platform** for education about gender equality LLLP (<http://lawgem.ius.bg.ac.rs>).

The final fifth intellectual output is the **Empirical Survey Tool (EST)**, which includes the desk research and the questionnaire, which cover different issues related to the institutional, educational, and cultural frameworks of the academic community, and is proposed to serve for surveying the views of the academic staff regarding gender equality issues in the case of all Consortium members, and subsequently for comparative analysis of the obtained results.

The LAWGEM project produced also numerous added value outcomes, including seven published books during 2021 and 2022, and one article.

- THE CALL FOR THE BEST STUDENTS' PAPER, 2020

The Centre for Human Rights had announced, in the cooperation with OSCE Mission to Serbia and in accordance with the proposed aims and measures of the Draft Action Plan for Achieving Gender Equality at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law, the call for the best student's paper, to be awarded in honour of Marina Blagojević Hughson, on the general topic 'Impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on gender equality'. The topic was selected bearing in mind the idea that the pandemic has caused different consequences for men and women and that strategic measures should take this fact into consideration, with the aim of mitigating and suppressing these inequalities. Consequently, the students of all study programmes of the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law are invited to write a paper on this topic, which will significantly contribute to the proper and complete understanding of gender equality in the field of law, especially during the state of emergency.

- UniSAFE PROJECT – Participation of the University of Belgrade in the UniSAFE project, 2019-2022.

UniSAFE was a three-year EU-funded research project. Its message was that it is time to end sexual harassment and gender-based violence in Academia and research. UniSAFE shortcut means – universities safe from gender-based violence. The goal of this project, in which University of Belgrade was an external partner, had been to produce in-depth knowledge on gender-based violence and sexual harassment in research-performing organizations, and to translate this research into operational tools for higher education and research organizations. Over three years, research and outreach activities were led across Europe, targeting researchers, stakeholders, and policymakers. The project has the plan to analyze the mechanisms of GBV - its social determinants, antecedents, and consequences - at three different levels, using a holistic research model, by basing the analysis on the data gathered by a survey among 45 RPOs (micro-level), on investigating organizational responses and infrastructure on the basis of data gathered by in-depth case studies, interviews, and strategic mapping of research organizations in 15 member states (meso level), and on examining legal and policy frameworks through extensive mapping by national experts in 27 European states and 3 associated states (macro level).

This multi-field research design attempts to provide in-depth knowledge of existing problems of gender-based violence in academia and research, to delineate current and future priorities, and to offer as the result the operational toolkit and recommendations to reduce gender-based violence in the European academic and research area.

- SPRING SCHOOL, 22 May - 5 June 2023, hybrid format

For the purpose of preparing the academic staff for this master program implementation, the Spring School Law and Gender was held at the Faculty of Law with the support of the OSCE Mission to Serbia. A total of 69 candidates, including Serbian (47) and international (22) undergraduates, MA, and PhD students, participated in this Spring School. Participants hailed from various countries, including Albania, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, China,

Croatia, France, Germany, India, Iran, Italy, Montenegro, Russia, Serbia, and Vietnam, demonstrating their dedication and intense involvement over the two-week duration of the school.

All attendees were required to complete four compulsory courses: Feminist Political and Legal Theories, Human Rights Law with a Gender Perspective, International and European Law and Gender Equality, and Feminist Judgements. Additionally, they were obliged to participate in two mandatory skill-based courses: Methodology and Practical Skills, and the Gender Equality Legal Clinic. Furthermore, each student had the opportunity to select five optional courses from a pool of eleven. The optional courses included Public Law and Gender Equality, Gender Issues in Comparative Legal History, Gender Economics, Gender Equality and Business Law, Gender Equitable Taxation, Gender Competent Criminology, Gender Competent Criminal Law, Gender Competent Family Law, Sociology of Law and Gender Equality, Public Policies and Gender Equality, and Gender Perspective in Labour Law. Each course consisted of three lectures, with continuous encouragement of active student participation and discussions.

- LAWGEM FOLLOW-UP APPLICATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

Orebro University, LUMSA University and Faculty of Law University of Belgrade received in July 2023 the grant for the Erasmus Design Measures Program (EMDM) with the title LAW, GENDER, INTERSECTIONALITY AND DIVERSITY (LAWGID), which will last 15 months, and which aims at preparing the application for the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master (EMJM) with the same title.
