

IVANA KRSTIĆ je redovna profesorka Pravnog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu, na kojem predaje Međunarodno pravo ljudskih prava, kao i druge srodne kurseve na Katedri za međunarodno pravo i međunarodne odnose. Upravnica je Centra za ljudska prava i Instituta za pravne i društvene nauke Pravnog fakulteta. Njena uža oblast istraživanja jeste antidiskriminaciono pravo, rodna ravnopravnost i izbegličko pravo. Članica je ekspertske Evropske mreže za antidiskriminaciono pravo (EELN). Objavila je veliki broj radova na temu nediskriminacije i rodne ravnopravnosti i učestvovala je u brojnim letnjim školama za studente i obukama za profesionalce.

Pripremila je analizu zakonodavnog antidiskriminacionog okvira i prakse u Republici Srbiji, a učestvovala je i u izradi Antidiskriminacione strategije i akcionih planova. Bila je deo tima Pravnog fakulteta koji je pripremio istraživačko-stratešku studiju za postizanje rodne ravnopravnosti na Pravnom fakultetu. Članica je LAWGEM tima na Pravnom fakultetu i zajedno sa profesorkom Dragicom Vujadinović glavna urednica Springer edicije Rodne perspektive u pravu (Gender Perspectives in Law). Učestvuje i u projektu Feminističke presude u centralnoj i istočnoj Evropi (Feminist judgments in Central and Eastern Europe).

Rukovodi radom Pravne klinike za pitanja diskriminacije, kao i grupom eksperata Pravnog fakulteta koja ima za cilj da vrši nadzor nad implementacijom Istanbulske konvencije o sprečavanju i borbi protiv nasilja nad ženama i nasilja u porodici.

IVANA KRSTIĆ is a Full Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade, where she teaches International Human Rights Law, as well as other related courses at the Department of International Law and International Relations. She is the director of the Center for Human Rights and the Institute for Legal and Social Sciences of the Faculty of Law. Her special area of interest is anti-discrimination law, gender equality, and refugee law. She is a Serbian expert at the European Equality Law Network (EELN). She widely published papers concerning non-discrimination and gender equality and she participated in numerous summer schools for students and conducted trainings for professionals.

She prepared an analysis of the legislative anti-discrimination framework and practice in the Republic of Serbia and participated in the drafting of the Anti-Discrimination Strategy and action plans. She was a member of the team that prepared a research-strategic study for achieving gender equality at the Faculty of Law. She is a member of the LAWGEM team at the Faculty of Law and, together with Prof. Dr. Dragica Vujadinović is editor-in-chief of the Springer edition Gender Perspectives in Law. She also participates in the project Feminist Judgments in Central and Eastern Europe.

She coordinates the Legal Clinic for Antidiscrimination Law, as well as the group of experts of the Faculty of Law, which aims to supervise the implementation of the Istanbul Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence.

DRAGICA VUJADINOVIĆ je redovna profesorka Pravnog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu na kojem predaje predmete na različitim nivoima studija (osnovne i master): Političke i pravne teorije, Studije roda, Savremene političke teorije, kao i Uvod u politički sistem Evropske unije.

Upravnica je master programa koji se u celini izvodi na engleskom jeziku - Master evropskih integracija. Koordinatorica je za Univerzitet u Beogradu za evropski projekat u kome je Univerzitet u Beogradu nosilac projekta – Strateško partnerstvo za visoko obrazovanje, pod nazivom Novi kvalitet obrazovanja za rodnu ravnopravnost – Strateško partnerstvo za razvoj master studijskog programa Rod i pravo – LAWGEM (2019-2022). Takođe je kontakt osoba za evropski projekat u kome je Univerzitet u Beogradu spoljnji partner – UniSAFE, (2019-2022) projekat za suzbijanje rodno zasnovanog nasilja na univerzitetima. DRAGICA VUJADINOVIĆ is a Full Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade, where she teaches a number of courses at different levels (undergraduate and master): Political and Legal Theories, Gender Studies, and Introduction to the EU Political System in the Masters in European Integration (MEI) program.

She is the Head of the Master’s in European Integration (MEI) program. She was the coordinator of the University of Belgrade for the Erasmus Mundus project for the development of the Master’s Study Program Law and Gender – LAWGEM, (2019-2029). The consortium universities were LUMSA University, Saarland University, Cadiz University, and Orebro University. She was also the coordinator for the University of Belgrade for the UniSAFE project (2019-2022), which has been related to combatting gender-based violence in academia. She is a member of the faculty of Law team for the project Building Gender Equality through Gender Budgeting for Institutional Transformation – BUDGET IT (2022-2025). She is the contact person within the Faculty of Law University of Belgrade (UB) team for the Erasmus Mundus Design Measures project (EMDM) (2023-2024, 15 months), which Orebro University

gained together with the University of Belgrade and LUMSA University, for preparing the future joint master program Law, Gender, Intersectionality and Diversity (LAWGID).

TANASIJE MARINKOVIĆ je redovni profesor Ustavnog prava na Univerzitetu u Beogradu Pravnom fakultetu. Na tom fakultetu je diplomirao i doktorirao, a magistrirao je na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta Pariz I. Usavršavao se i istraživao je i na drugim evropskim visokoškolskim ustanovama: Univerzitetu u Oksfordu, Univerzitetu u Bordou, Centralnoevropskom univerzitetu u Budimpešti, Međunarodnom institutu za ljudska prava u Strazburu i Univerzitetu u Friburu.

Na poziv Ustavnog suda Republike Srbije učestvovao je u više javnih rasprava. Član je Republičke izborne komisije i Odbora za rodnu ravnopravnost Univerziteta u Beogradu. TANASIJE MARINKOVIĆ is a Full Professor of Constitutional Law at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law. He also studied and researched at the University of Oxford, the University of Bordeaux, the Central European University in Budapest, the International Institute of Human Rights in Strasbourg, and the University of Fribourg.

He has testified as an expert witness in a number of cases before the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Serbia. He is a member of the Electoral Commission of the Republic of Serbia and of the University of Belgrade Gender Equality Committee. As a local expert of the Council of Europe, he has lectured on the application of the European Convention on Human Rights in numerous seminars for the judges and registry of the basic, higher, and appellate courts as well as of the Administrative Court and the Supreme Court of Serbia.

BOJANA ČUČKOVIĆ je vanredna profesorka Pravnog fakulteta Univerziteta u Beogradu, na kojem predaje Međunarodno javno pravo i Međunarodno pravo ljudskih prava, kao i druge srodne kurseve na Katedri za međunarodno pravo i međunarodne odnose.

Doktorirala je na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu 2012. godine, gde je završila i magistarske studije. Master studije iz oblasti međunarodnog prava i međunarodnih organizacija pohađala je na Univerzitetu Pariz I Panteon-Sorbona. Predaje više kurseva na različitim nivoima studija (osnovne, master i doktorske): Međunarodno javno pravo, Ljudska prava, Pravo i politika životne sredine EU, Pravo i politika azila i migracija EU, Međunarodno pravo zaštite životne sredine i Pravna klinika.

Bojana Čučković je angažovana kao ekspertkinja i konsultantkinja od strane više međunarodnih organizacija i agencija (Visoki komesarijat za izbeglice Ujedinjenih nacija, Međunarodna organizacija za migracije, Savet Evrope, OEBS). Učestvovala je na nekoliko međunarodnih projekata, kako u svojstvu rukovoditeljke istraživačkog tima tako i kao članica istraživačkog tima, od kojih su pojedini bili posvećeni rodnim pitanjima. Konkretno, bila je članica LAWGEM projektnog tima, Erasmus + projekta koji se bavio različitim aspektima prava i roda. Objavila je više naučnih radova i učestvovala na konferencijama i seminarima o rodnim perspektivama u pravu i studijama prava. Bila je predavačica na „Prolećnoj školi - Pravo i rod“, koju je organizovao Pravni fakultet Univerziteta u Beogradu u junu 2023. U saradnji sa partnerima iz međunarodnih i organizacija civilnog društva redovno organizuje

predavanja i radionice i angažuje studente u aktivnostima u vezi s rodnim aspektima prava, posebno u okviru pravnih klinika za azil i trgovinu ljudima.

BOJANA ČUČKOVIĆ is an Associate Professor of Public International Law and International Human Rights Law at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade. She holds a Ph.D. in Public International Law, obtained at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law in 2012, and an LL.M. in International Law and International Organisations, obtained at *Université Paris I Panthéon-Sorbonne* (France) in 2006.

She teaches a number of courses at different levels (undergraduate, master, and doctoral): Public International Law, Human Rights Law, EU Environmental Law and Policy, EU Immigration and Asylum Law and Policy, International Environmental Law and Legal Clinic. Bojana Čučković has been engaged as an expert and consultant by a number of international governmental organisations and agencies (UNHCR, IOM, Council of Europe, OSCE). She has participated in several international projects, both as a research team leader and as a research team member, some of which were related to gender issues. In particular, she was a member of the LAWGEM project team, an Erasmus + project dealing with various aspects of law and gender. She has published several academic papers and participated in conferences and seminars on gender perspectives in law and legal studies. She was a lecturer at the Spring School „Law and Gender“, organised by the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade in June 2023. In cooperation with partners from international and civil society organisations, she regularly organises special sessions and engages students in activities related to gender aspects of law, especially within legal clinics on asylum and human trafficking.

Her research on various issues of public international law, in particular international human rights law and international environmental law, has also focused on gender perspectives. SVETISLAV V. KOSTIĆ je vanredni profesor na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu gde drži nastavu na osnovnim (Poresko pravo i Pravo međunarodnih poreskih ugovora), kao i na postdiplomskim studijama. Osnovne oblasti njegovog interesovanja su neposredni porezi, međunarodno oporezivanje i pravo međunarodnih poreskih ugovora.

Do 2016. godine prof. dr Svetislav Kostić je bio i direktor sektora za poreske usluge konsultantske kuće Diloit. Jedan je od osnivača Srpskog fiskalnog društva u kome trenutno obavlja dužnost Generalnog sekretara. U okviru pitanja roda, profesor Kostić je zajednički sa profesorom Markom Davinićem uredio knjigu „Gender Competent Public Law and Policies“, u okviru Springer edicije Rodne perspektive u pravu (Gender Perspectives in Law), i bio predavač na „Prolećnoj školi - Pravo i rod“ na temu „Gender Competent Tax Law“.

SVETISLAV V. KOSTIĆ is an Associate Professor of Tax Law at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law teaching at both undergraduate and graduate levels. His primary areas of expertise are direct taxation, international taxation, and tax treaty law.

Until 2016 Prof. Kostić also held the post of Director with Deloitte Serbia Tax Services. He is one of the founders of the Serbian branch of the International Fiscal Association (IFA), currently in the capacity of its Secretary General. In regards to gender-related topics, Professor Kostić co-edited a book together with Professor Marko Davinić “Gender Competent Public Law and Policies“, as part of the Springer edition Gender Perspectives in Law, and held a lecture at Spring School „Law and Gender“ on the topic of „Gender Competent Tax Law“.

MAJA LUKIĆ RADOVIĆ je vanredna profesorka na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu, na predmetima Uvod u pravo evropskih integracija i Međunarodne organizacije. Doktorirala je na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu 2013. godine, a magistrirala na Univerzitetu Pariz I Panteon-Sorbona iz oblasti međunarodnog prava i međunarodnih organizacija. Završila je pripravnički staž za advokatsku praksu u Francuskoj u pariskoj kancelariji advokatske firme *Cabinet De Guillenchmidt & Baillet*, kao i pripravnički staž za advokatsku praksu u Srbiji u *kancelariji Dražić i Beatović*. Položila je pravosudni ispit u Republici Srbiji 2006. godine. U Srbiji se bavila advokaturom od 2006. do 2009. godine, kao starija saradnica međunarodne advokatske firme *Gide Loyrette Nouel*. Od 2009. do 2011. bila je angažovana kao savetnica / *Of Counsel* globalne advokatske kancelarije DLA Piper.

Bila je članica LAWGEM projektnog tima. Predaje više kurseva na različitim nivoima studija (osnovne, master i doktorske): Uvod u pravo Evropskih integracija, Međunarodne organizacije, Međunarodni odnosi EU, Sudski sistem EU i Zajednička poljoprivredna politika EU. Predavala je i predstavljala stručne radove u SAD (Harvard Law School), Francuskoj, Austriji, Italiji, Nemačkoj, Crnoj Gori, Makedoniji, Hrvatskoj i Albaniji. Njena dosadašnja istraživanja obuhvataju pravo međunarodnih ugovora, institucionalno pravo EU, spoljne odnose EU, pravno uređenje finansijskih usluga u EU i pravo ljudskih prava.

MAJA LUKIĆ RADOVIĆ is an Associate Professor of EU Law at the Faculty of Law, University of Belgrade. She earned her Ph.D. degree from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law in 2013 and an LL.M. degree from the University Paris 1, Panthéon-Sorbonne, Department of International Law and International Organizations in 2002. She completed a traineeship for the practice of law in France with law firm *Cabinet De Guillenchmidt & Baillet*, in its office in Paris, as well as for the practice of law in Serbia with law firm *Dražić & Beatović*. She passed the Serbian bar exam in 2006 and practiced law in Serbia from 2006 until 2009, as a senior associate of international law firm *Gide Loyrette Nouel*. From 2009 until 2011 she was Of Counsel for global law firm *DLA Piper*. While practicing law she handled regularly cases involving gender discrimination, in addition to corporate law matters.

She was a member of the LAWGEM project team. She teaches a number of courses at different levels (undergraduate, master, and doctoral): general courses on EU law, International organizations, International Relations of the EU, the Judicial System of the EU, and the Common Agricultural Policy of the EU. She has lectured and presented in the USA (Harvard Law School), France, Austria, Italy, Germany, Croatia, Macedonia, Montenegro and Albania. Her research interests include the law of international treaties, EU institutional law, EU external relations law, and regulation of financial services at the EU level, Human Rights Law.

IVANA MARKOVIĆ je docentkinja na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu, na kojem predaje Krivično pravo. Doktorirala je na matičnom fakultetu u oblasti materijalnog krivičnog prava (naslov disertacije: „Pomaganje kao oblik saučesništva u krivičnom pravu“), a na istom fakultetu je stekla i dve diplome master akademskih studija („Materijalno krivično pravo Evropske unije“ i „Gender Equality in the Jurisprudence of the European Court of Human Rights“). Pored toga, završila je i LL.M. studije na nemačkom i engleskom jeziku iz prava konkurencije i regulacije tržišta na Pravnom fakultetu Univerziteta u Manhajmu (Universität Mannheim, These: „Wettbewerb und Nachhaltigkeit: Sind Umweltschutzziele in der Effizienzeinrede zu berücksichtigen?“).
