

Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition

The University of Belgrade Faculty of Law is pleased to announce the open call for fourth year/master students for the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition.

The Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition is the world's largest moot court competition, with participants from roughly 700 law schools in 100 countries and jurisdictions. The Competition is a simulation of a fictional dispute between countries in the field of Public International Law before the International Court of Justice, the judicial organ of the United Nations. Teams of law students compete against one another through the presentation of oral and written pleadings to address timely issues of public international law in the context of a hypothetical legal dispute between nations.

The deadline for submitting applications is Sunday, 8 September 2024.
