The Central and Eastern European Legal History Conference (CEELHC), first organized in 2019 in Wien, and again in 2023 in Budapest, will take place next year in Cracow. It will be hosted at the Faculty of Law and Administration at the Jagiellonian University in Cracow.

We want to invite all interested scholars to take part in our conference. Registration is open to all researchers who deal with Central and Eastern European legal history and political doctrines. We ask you to submit only contributions that are thematically related to the broadly conceived legal history of Central and Eastern Europe.

## The conference language will be English and German.

In addition to the proceedings in sections, the time will also be reserved for the 3MT (Three Minute Thesis) competition. Young researchers, especially doctoral students, are invited to participate in the 3MT competition.

The conference fee is 200 EUR

(with a reduction to 150 EUR for doctoral students) and covers lunches, coffee breaks, dinners, conference materials, and a tour to Collegium Maius. The conference fee does not

include accommodation costs. The organizers are providing limited hotel reservations that can be booked until September 8, 2025.


