Juan Montero is Director at the Florence School of Regulation and Full Professor at UNED in Madrid. He is a leading expert in the regulation of traditional network industries-particularly railways, aviation, and telecommunications-as well as emerging network sectors such as digital platforms and their interactions.

His research focuses on the evolving dynamics between infrastructure, competition, and regulation in increasingly interconnected markets. He is the author of key works in the field, including Handbook in Railway Regulation, The Rise of the New Network Industries. Regulating Digital Platforms. His latest book is Challenges in Transport Regulation in Europe and Beyond
